If you pass Lifeguard Training and work 250 hours at the Aquatic Park in 2017, we will pay you \$5.00 per hour for your time spent in class **PLUS** give you \$100.00 to offset the course enrollment fee.

In addition, after you work 250 hours in 2017, you'll receive a \$50.00 end of year bonus. If 60 of those 250 hours are earned from August 11 - August 26, you'll get **ANOTHER** \$50.00 bonus.

Sign on to work the following season and receive **ANOTHER** \$100.00 to offset the course enrollment fee after working 250 hours. **Plus**, qualify for the additional end of year bonuses!
