

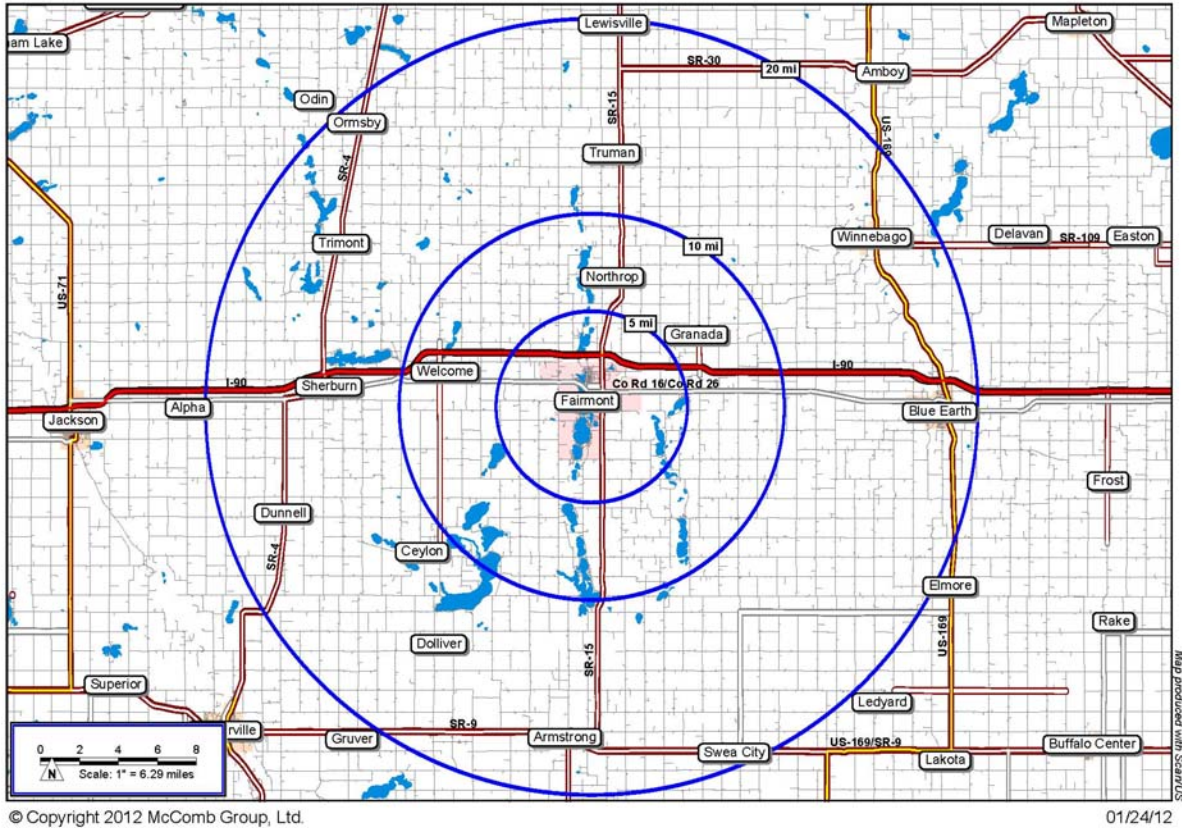

FAIRMONT 5, 10 AND 20 MILE RINGS



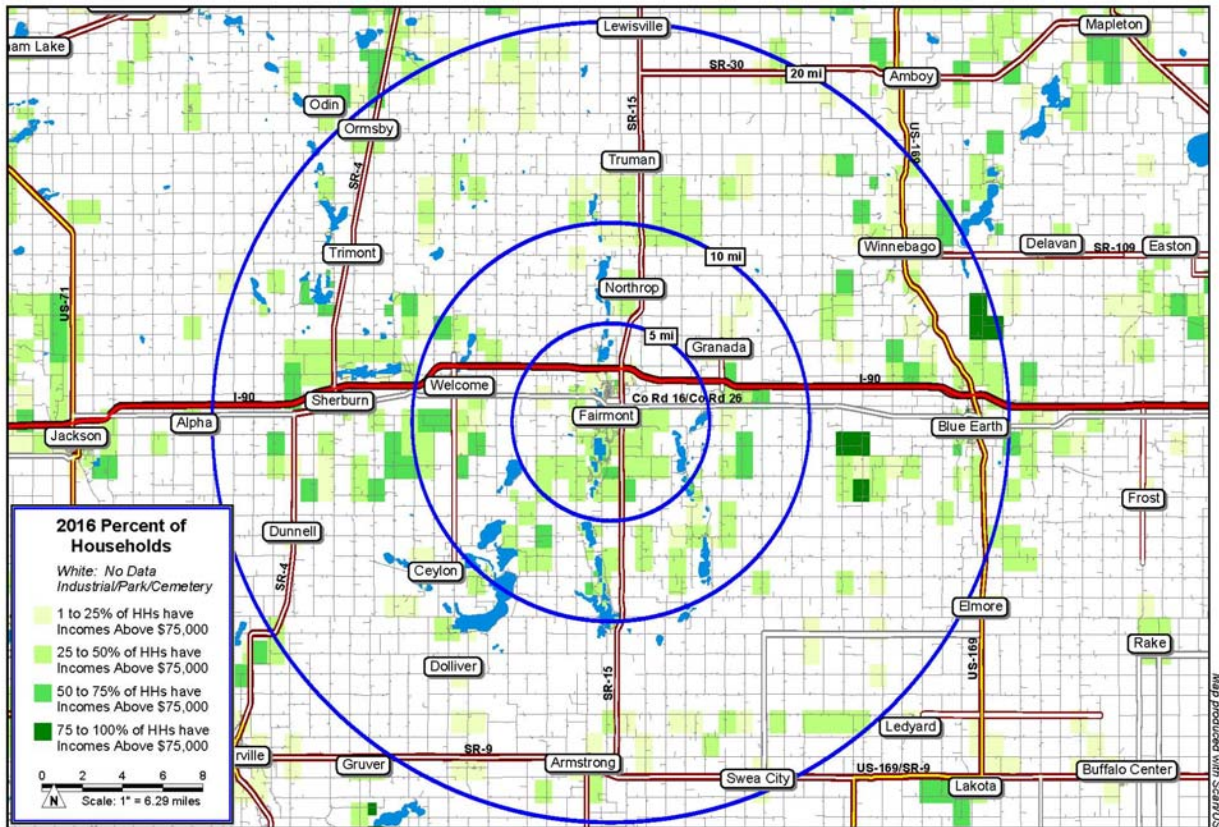
