New Business: None

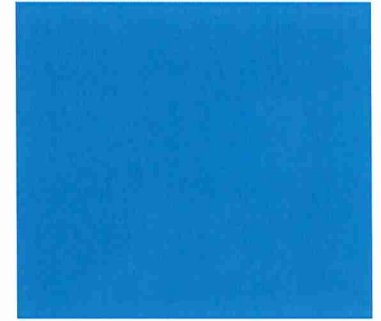

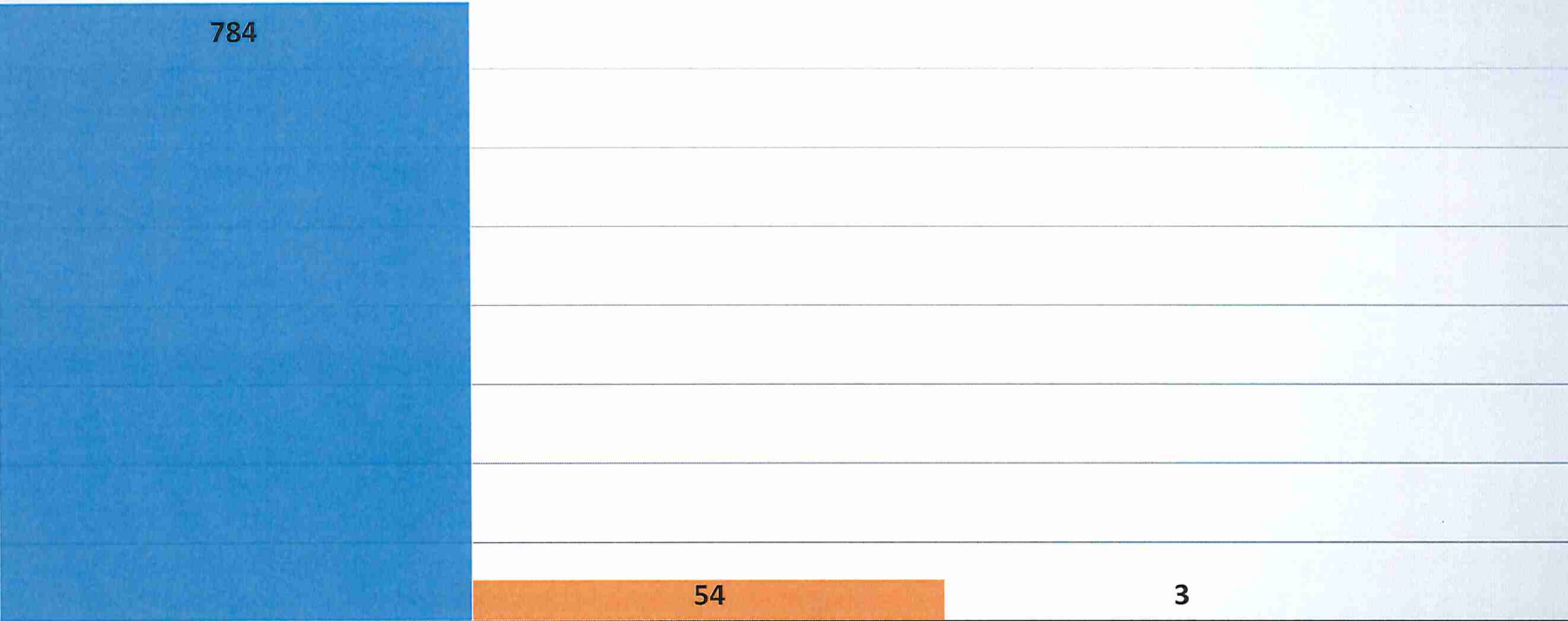

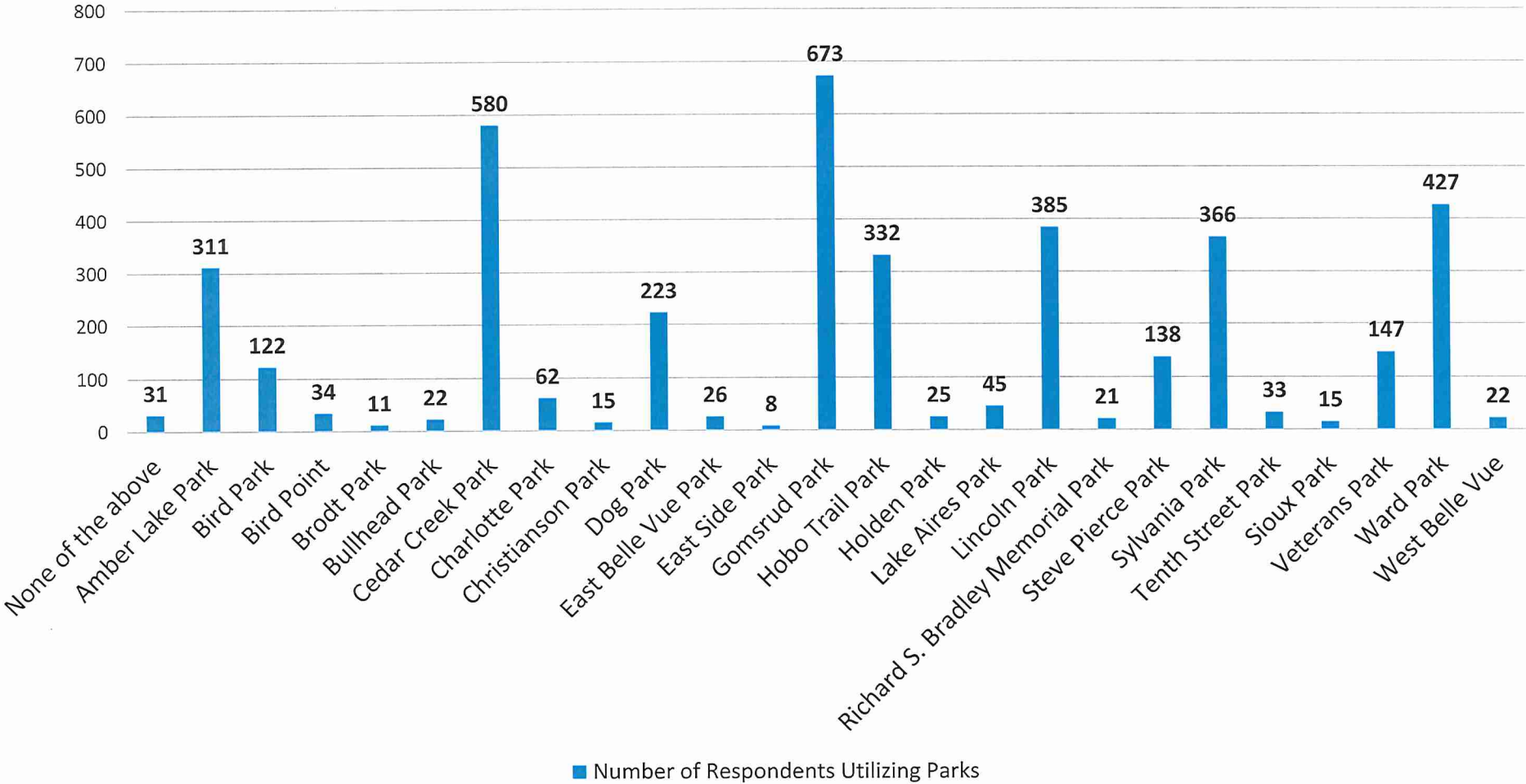
Respondents That Utilize City Parks

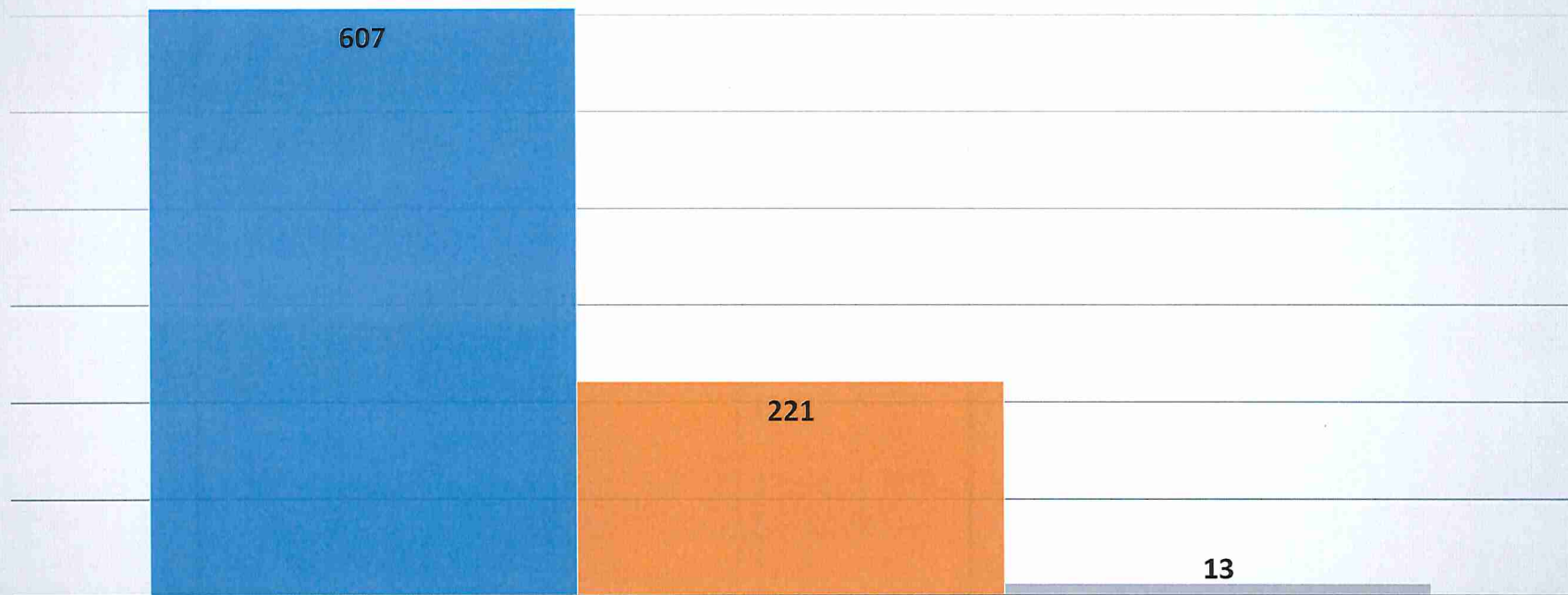

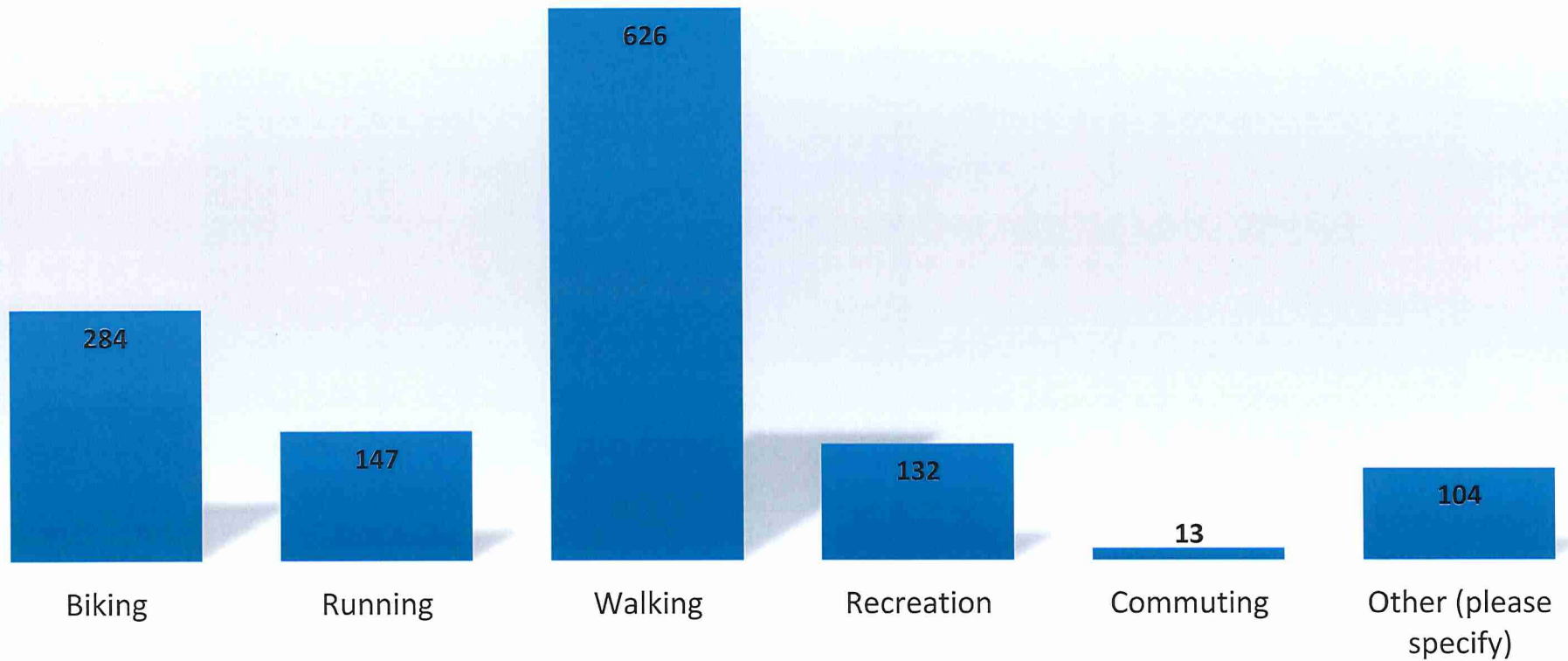


NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS UTILIZING TRAILS

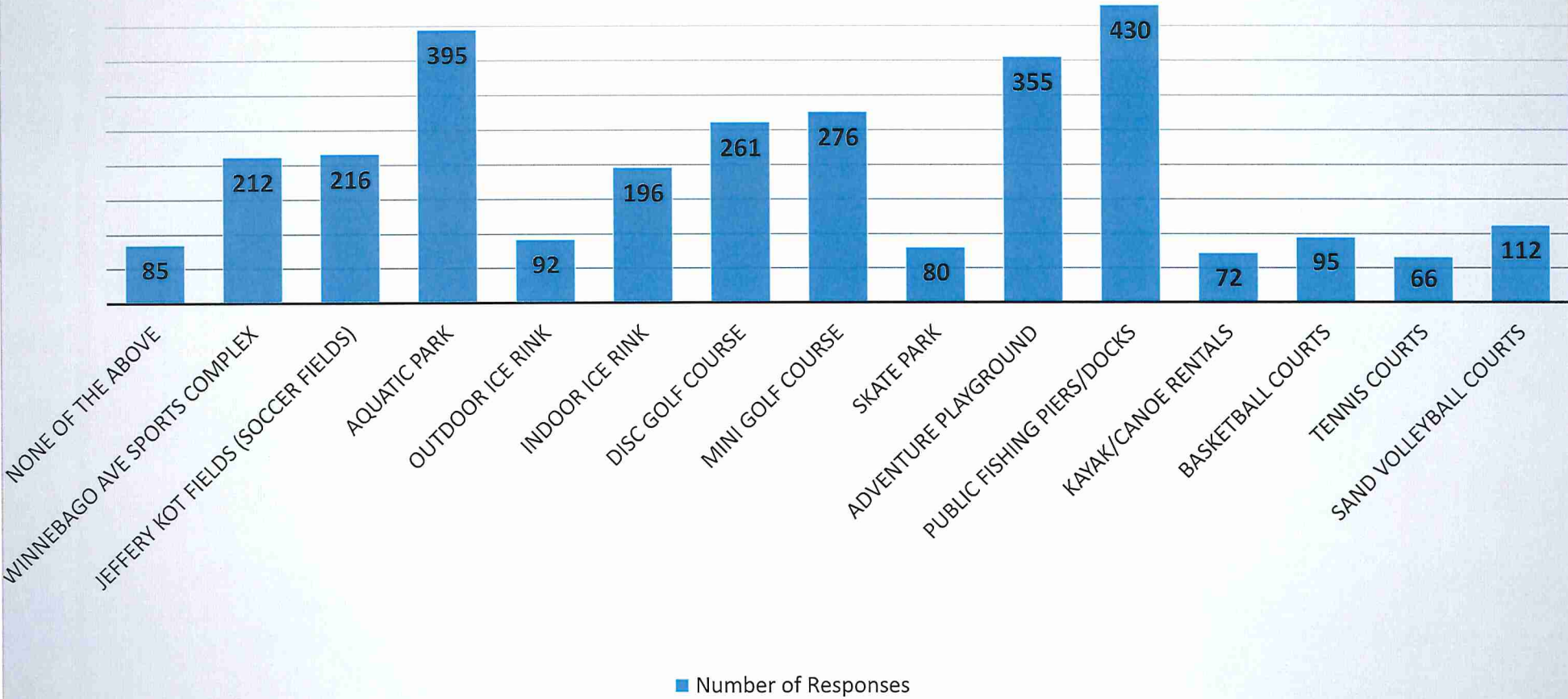

Primary Reason for using the City Trail System

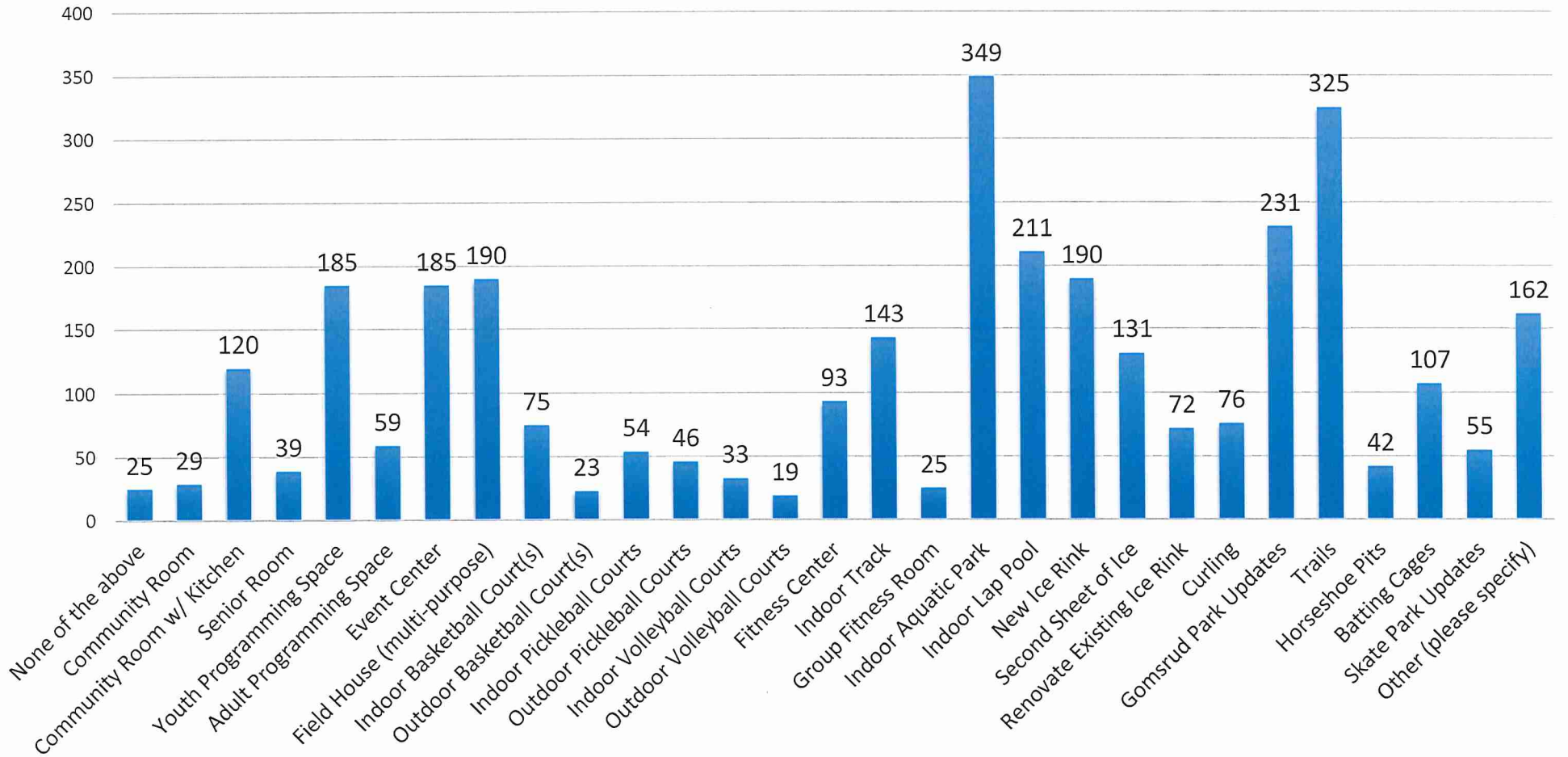
■ Number of Responses



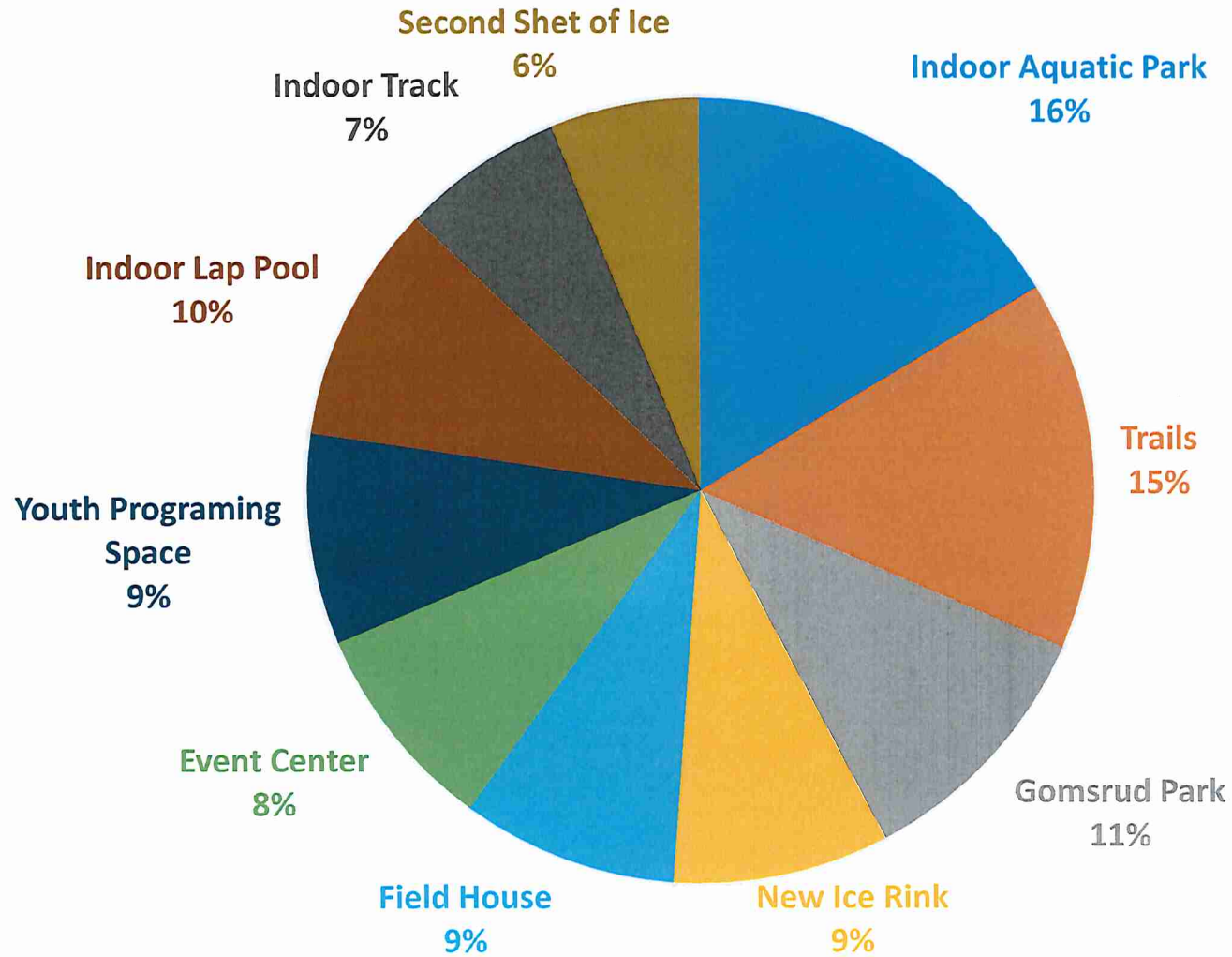
City Recreational Facility Use



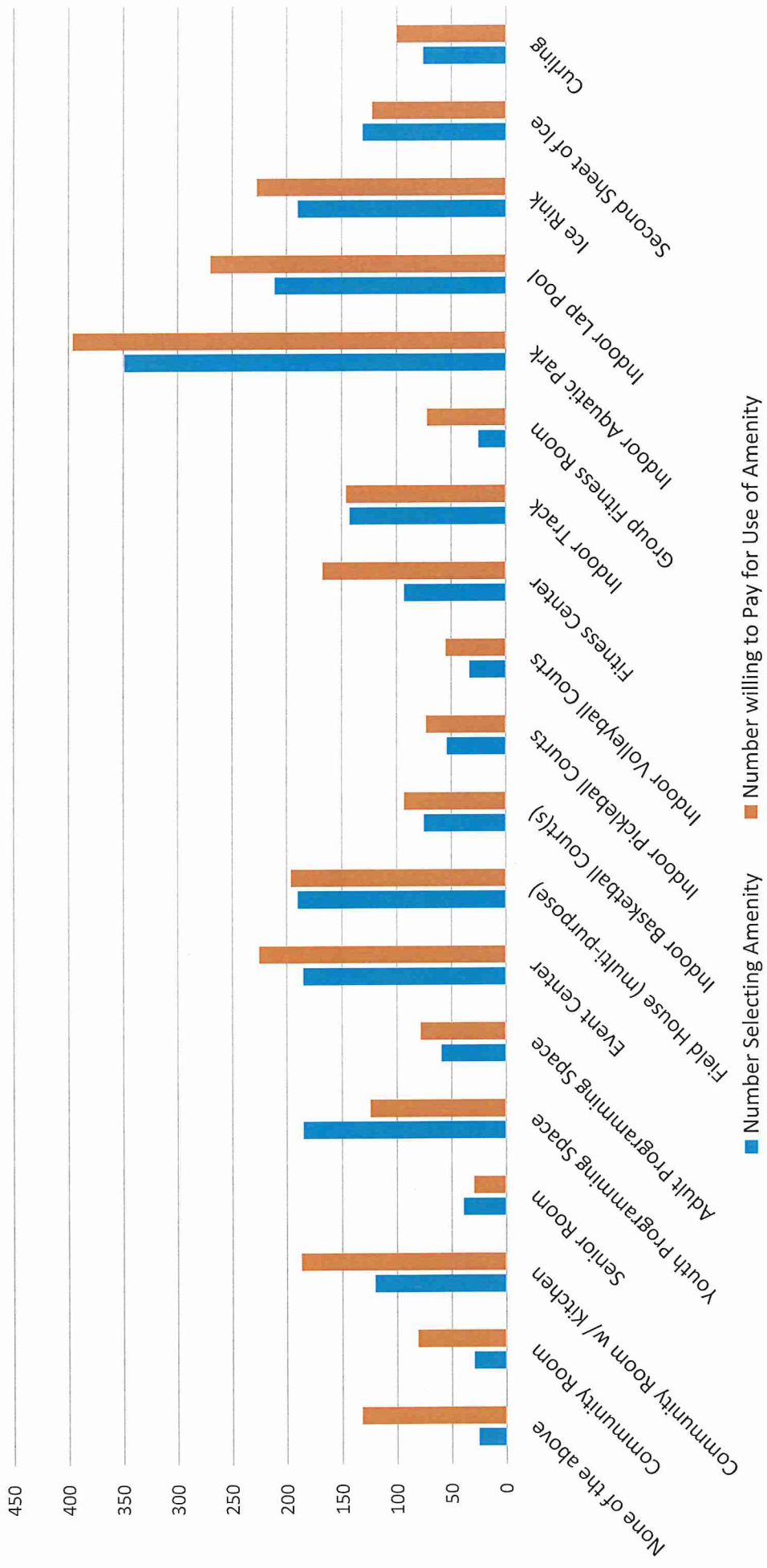
Amenities Selected for City Investment
