The minutes of the Fairmont City Council meeting held on Monday, June 14, 2021 at the City Hall Council Chambers.

Mayor Deborah J. Foster called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Members Wayne Hasek, Britney Kawecki, Randy Lubenow, Michele Miller and Bruce Peters were present. Also, in attendance: City Administrator Cathy Reynolds, Public Works Director/City Engineer Troy Nemmers, Finance Director Paul Hoye, Police Chief Mike Hunter, City Clerk Patricia J. Monsen and Attorney Mark Rahrck.

Council Member Peters made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Hasek seconded the motion and the motion carried.

During Public Discussion/Comment, Amy Long of 3819 Cedar Creek gave a presentation by the Community Center Committee and the Fairmont Hockey Association.

Jay Maynard of 1831 Oakwood Drive spoke in favor of the Community Center.

Alex Young Williams of 107 Downtown Plaza invited the public to the Multicultural Festival and Vaccination Clinic to be held on Downtown Plaza June 26, 2021. The event will include Food Truck Vendors, musical groups and activities for kids. The event is sponsored by Community Education and Recreation.

Ruth Cyphers of 103 Oxford urged the City Council to support the community center.

Marge Johnston of 506 Day Street questioned the Council on the funding for the community center and where the extra funding would be coming from and how the citizens would pay for it.

Siri Kabrick of 202 Woodland Avenue spoke in favor of the community center.

Council Member Kawecki presented a petition from a Downtown Business Owner. The petition was to have the City Hall bathrooms open to the public on Saturdays and was signed by 600 people.

Council Member Miller made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Peters seconded the motion and the motion carried. Items on the Consent Agenda were: Minutes from the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting; Event Permit for CER to hold a Multicultural Festival and Vaccination Clinic on Downtown Plaza on June 26, 2021; Event Permit for Fairmont Lions to hold their annual Fly in Breakfast at the Airport on June 27, 2021; Request from Light Noise and Smoke of Fairmont for a donation to the July 4th Fireworks in the amount of \$1,500.00; One Day Temporary On-Sale Liquor License for Martin County Chapter Pheasants Forever for August 28, 2021; Change Order No. 1 with Barr Engineering on the Dutch Creek Habitat Project in the amount of \$47,350.00; Declare a Hach 850 Colorimeter as excess property to be sold; and Authorize the purchase of used Case 1650L Dozer.

Mayor Foster opened the public hearing for proposed **Ordinance 2021-02**, an ordinance amending **Ordinance 2020-08** establishing a rural and urban service district within the municipal limits of the City of Fairmont. No public comment was received. Council Member

Peters made a motion to close the public hearing. Council Member Hasek seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding the Community Center. Council Member Lubenow made a motion to give City Staff the ability to move forward with Path 1 as presented by the Community Center Committee. Council Member Peters seconded the motion. On roll call: Council Members Kawecki, Lubenow and Peters voted aye. Council Members Miller and Hasek voted nay. Mayor Foster declared said motion passed. (Community Center Committee presentation handout, dated June 14, 2021, is hereby incorporated in these minutes. "Path 1" Council chooses to honor December 2019 commitment.)

Council Member Lubenow made a motion to accept the proposal from Press Gold Group for HR system including payroll and timekeeping. Council Member Miller seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding curbside pickup for the City-wide clean-up. Council consensus was to come up with a plan to help people in need by utilizing volunteer service organizations for the September 2021 clean-up opportunities. The plan will include how to inform all residents of this service and to get commitment from the service organizations.

Discussion was held regarding the city hiring or contracting for structural engineer services. Reynolds stated that by doing this, the city would assume liability. Council Member Lubenow wanted more facts and data on how the city would assume liability.

District 23A Representative Bjorn Olson from Elmore, MN was present at the Council meeting and introduced himself.

Discussion was held regarding the time limit for citizens to speak during public comment. Consensus was to keep the current time limit of three minutes in place for now, but to bring it back for discussion in the future, if the council feels this needs to be adjusted.

Discussion was held regarding the Rental Housing Ordinance. Staff is currently researching and updating the existing rental ordinance. Once a recommended draft is prepared and reviewed by the City Attorney, it will be brought before council for review and public hearing.

Discussion was held on the potential sale of the Aquatic Park. Council Member Kawecki made a motion to look into selling the Aquatic Park. Council Member Miller seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding camping within city limits.

Nemmers reported that the pavement markings on the Lake Avenue construction project are being completed. Construction continues on the Margarete Street trail, Fairlakes Avenue and the Public Works Building. The Grant Street watermain project will begin next week. Painting of the Industrial Water Towers is currently happening. Reminder that City-wide clean-up will be tomorrow from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to noon on Marcus Street.

Hoye stated that he has been working on a Request for Proposals for a five-year contract for auditing services. Hoye is hoping to have the proposals back to the council at the August 9th council meeting.

Reynolds advised that she and Chief Hunter had a meeting with the Martin County Justice Center Committee to discuss the new Justice Center and the relationship with the Fairmont Police Department. It is the City's intent to continue to share services and technology. A Memorandum of Understanding will be prepared and brought to the council for consideration.

The League of Minnesota Cities will be holding a virtual Annual Conference on June 23 through June 25. If council members are not registered yet but would like to participate, please contact Cathy.

The City will be hosting "Conversations with the City". This will be a time for citizens to meet with staff to ask questions, get answers and for staff to listen to citizens' concerns. The first event will be held at Gomsrud Park on June 17th from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The events will be held every other month through this year and will be in different Wards.

An informational work session on TIF and Tax Abatement is planned for July 12th from 4:30 p.m. to 5:15 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers. FEDA and the HRA will be invited to attend this work session.

Mayor Foster reported that the HRA had general discussion on foreclosures, low interest loan programs and property purchases. Linsey Preuss, Economic Development Coordinator, attended the HRA meeting to invite them to the TIF and Tax Abatement work session.

Council Member Hasek reported on the Airport Board. The airport will be hosting the Lion's Fly-in Breakfast on June 27th.

Council Member Kawecky reported that the Planning Commission met on June 1st and held a public hearing on the conditional use permit for 440 Winnebago Avenue and 1313 North Hampton, Car Parts Direct. The recommendation was for staff to not support the conditional use permit, due to noncompliance. A work session on this is scheduled for June 15th at 5:30 p.m. and the public is welcomed to attend.

Council Member Lubenow reported on the Library Board. Most of the meeting was discussion on the Trimont branch, which has a job opening. The Martin County Library will be opening back up for kids' activities in the basement and the large open area.

Council Member Lubenow also reported that the Board of Zoning Appeals reviewed and approved some surface changes for the Marina Lodge.

Council Member Miller reported on Community Education and Recreation. CER thanked Roni Dauer for her 47 years of service and welcomed Stephanie Busiahn as the new CER Director. Mat Mahoney spoke at the meeting. Summer activities have started. Activities with Fairmont Early Childhood initiative are underway. Check CER's calendar for many free family activities. GED enrollments are on the rise.

Council Member Miller reported on FEDA. An offer on a lot at Whitetail Ridge was discussed. Iowa Lakes Community College will be offering industry training classes at SMEC.

Council Member Peters reported on Visit Fairmont. Visit Fairmont wishes Stephanie Busiahn the best with CER. Visit Fairmont contracted with a company named Shrpa. Shrpa brings a family into Fairmont and gives them pointers on what there is to do in Fairmont. The family then reports on their visit to Fairmont. At 7:39 p.m., Council Member Miller made a motion to go into closed session pursuant to Minnesota Statute 13D.05, Subd. 3(d) for discussions regarding city hall security. Council Member Peters seconded the motion and the motion carried. The Council went into closed session at 7:47 p.m. At 8:10 p.m., Council Member Hasek made a motion to end the closed session. Council Member Lubenow seconded the motion and the motion carried.

At 8:20 p.m., Council Member Peters made a motion to go into closed session pursuant to Minnesota Statute 13C.05, Subd. 3(a) for the one-year performance evaluation of City Administrator Reynolds. Council Member Hasek seconded the motion and the motion carried. At 9:12 p.m., Council Member Miller made a motion to end the closed session. Council Member Peters seconded the motion and the motion carried.

At 9:14 p.m. the Fairmont City Council was back in open session. Council Member Hasek made a motion to approve a 3.5% pay increase for City Administrator Cathy Reynolds. Council Member Peters seconded the motion. On roll call: Council Members Lubenow, Hasek, Miller and Peters voted aye. Council Member Kawecky voted nay. Mayor Foster declared said motion passed.

A motion was made by Council Member Miller, seconded by Council Member Peters, and carried to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 p.m.

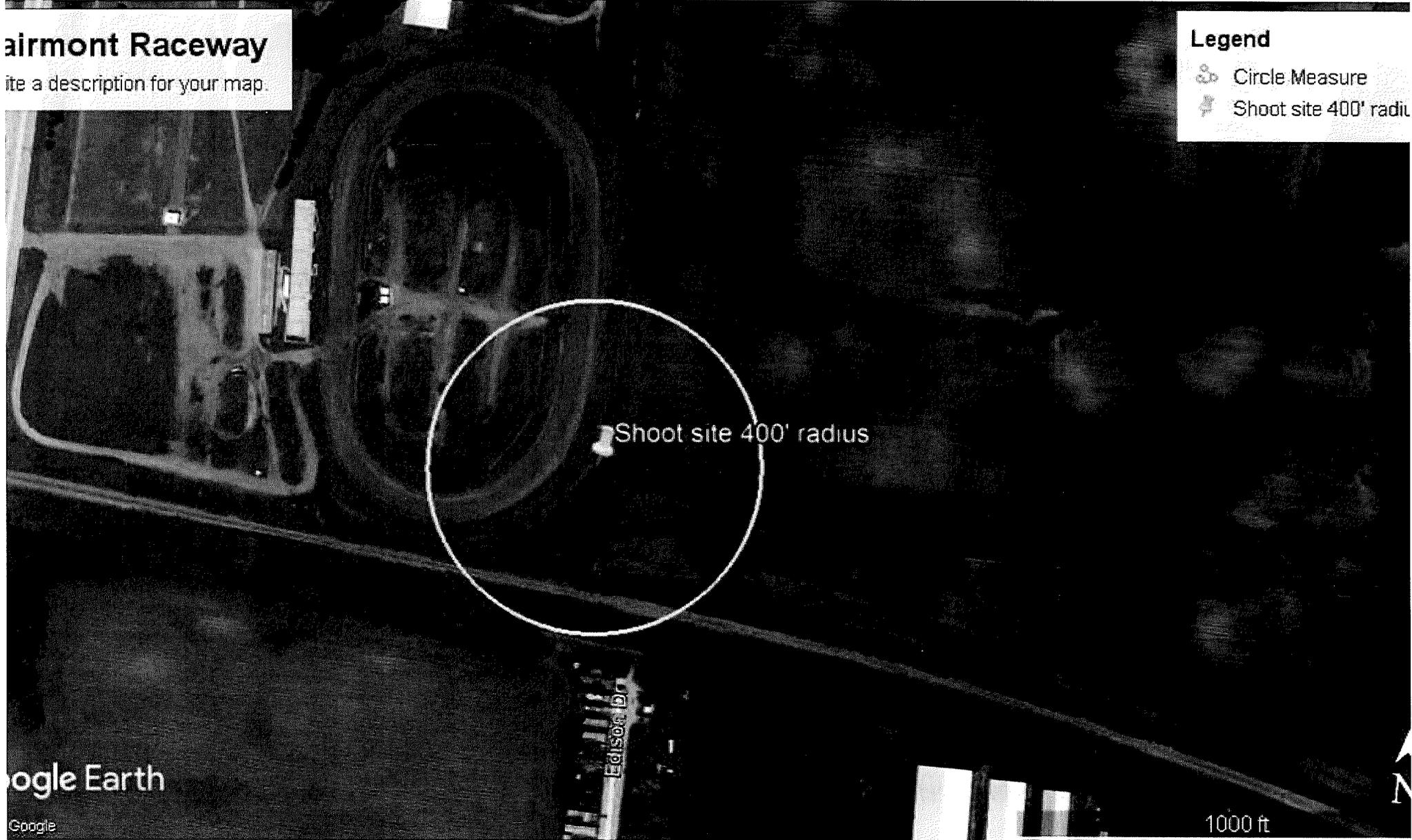

Policy/Action Requested: Motion to approve the Conditional Use Permit for a salvage yard at 1313 N Hampton St.

Vote Required: Simple Majority Roll Call

Recommendation: The Planning Commission recommends approval of the Conditional Use Permit to allow for a salvage yard as presented.

Overview: On Tuesday, June 8, the Planning Commission met to continue discussion of granting conditional use permits for two properties in which Car Parts Direct operates. The Planning Commission recommends approval of a Conditional Use Permit for 1313 N Hampton St for a salvage yard to operate with the following conditions:

1. That the business maintain an 8-foot fence around all vehicle storage areas.
2. The fence be maintained to adequately screen all contents.
3. That open storage and refuse from the use must be adequately controlled on-site. Parts and equipment must be stored indoors or within required screening.
4. That there be no draining of fluids or dismantling of vehicles on the site.
5. That the entire site other than that taken up by structures, plantings, or landscaping not used for storage be surfaced with a material to control dust and drainage. This surfacing is subject to approval by appropriate city staff.
6. That the business does not produce noise, light, or odor that is offensive to neighboring properties.
7. That business hours are between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
8. That the business provide adequate access to all parts of the yard for firefighting equipment.
9. That a building permit for the fence be granted within 6 months.

BACKGROUND

The permittee holds a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to operate a salvage yard in a light industrial (I-1) district at 440 Winnebago Avenue. Surrounding the lot are Single Family Residential (R-1) and I-1 uses. The CUP imposes several conditions for the use. Staff's review of the permit found multiple violations of these conditions.

Since 2009, Car Parts Direct has expanded its operations to 414 Winnebago Avenue, 410 Winnebago Avenue, and 1313 North Hampton Street - all down the street from the property covered by this CUP. Car Parts Direct uses these lots to store additional vehicles. Because the vehicles range in condition from operable to junk by Code's definition, a conditional use permit is required for the legal storage of these vehicles on these properties. No permit has been applied for or granted.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Section 26-160 of the Fairmont City Code provides for certain uses within the I-1 district that are conditional. These uses are not permitted by right but instead are granted subject to the Planning Commission's analysis of the use's impact on the public welfare. Per *Division 4* of the Zoning Code, the Planning Commission may impose on the use conditions relating to public welfare. In 2009, the Planning Commission imposed 12 conditions when granting Car Parts Direct's permit, which are discussed below.

Section 26-86 states that: "A violation of any condition set forth in a conditional use permit shall be a violation of this chapter and shall automatically void the permit".

REVIEW OF CONDITIONAL USE STANDARDS

The following conditions were required issued with the permit:

- 1. That the architectural appearance and functional plan of the building and site shall not be so dissimilar to the existing buildings or area so as to cause impairment in property values or constitute a blighting influence within a reasonable distance of the lot.**

Staff find that the permittee has violated this condition. The property contains storage of vehicles, parts, and salvage outside of the required fencing, which constitutes a blighting influence in the area. In addition, multiple lots used by Car Parts Direct to the west also store vehicles in violation of Code.

- 2. That the entire site other than that taken up by a building, structure, or plantings shall be surfaced with a material to control dust and drainage. This surfacing is subject to approval by appropriate city staff.**

Staff find no violation of this condition.

- 3. That the lighting shall be accomplished in such a way as to have no direct source of light visible from adjacent land in residential use or from public right-of-way.**

Staff find no violation of this condition.

- 4. That vehicular access points shall create a minimum of conflict with through traffic movement and shall comply with the requirements of this chapter.**

Staff find no violation of this condition on the property covered by this permit. Car Parts Direct's use of multiple lots to the west utilizes several access points which together conflict more significantly with traffic patterns.

- 5. That open storage and refuse from the use shall be adequately contained and controlled on the site.**

Staff find that the permittee has violated this condition. Storage and refuse can be obviously seen by neighbors and the public outside of the required fencing and on the adjacent public street. In addition, this storage expands to the other lots used by Car Parts Direct without fencing.

- 6. Any other condition as deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare:**

6(A). Business hours are not before 6:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m.

Staff find no violation of this condition.

6(B). Business must repair, paint, and make the fence presentable to the area.

Staff find no violation of this condition.

6(C). Business must landscape and establish plantings around the fence that take on a residential character.

Staff find no violation of this condition.

6(D). All cars, trucks, trailers, and accessory vehicles are stored behind the fence except for vehicles driven to work that day by the owner or employees.

Staff find that the permittee has violated this condition. Staff observed 16 vehicles on the site outside the required fencing as well as parked on the adjacent public street, apart from employee parking on the Winnebago Diamonds parking lot across the street. These vehicles ranged in condition from operable to junk, per Code's definition.

6(E). That the fence and fence gate must be solid so that the contents behind the fence are not visible from the street.

Staff find no violation of this condition.

6(F). There are no more than 25 cars on the premises at any given time.

Staff find that the permittee has violated this condition. Staff inspected and found approximately 44 vehicles on the site behind the fence, on the site visible from the street, and on the public street adjacent to the site. Additionally, Car Parts Direct stored more than 30 additional vehicles on multiple lots to the west, as counted at the time of inspection.

6(G). The conditions of fence, gate, and car limit be done within 90 days of issuance of the permit.

Staff find no violation of this condition.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff's inspection and evaluation found that four of the permit's 12 conditions were violated by the permittee. Together, these violations injure the public welfare of the surrounding area and general public.

It is staff's opinion that the Conditional Use Permit should be revoked per *Section 26-86* and that time should be provided for the permittee to apply for new conditional use permits covering 440 Winnebago Avenue and any other property where a permit is needed. The Planning Commission could take the following actions:

1. Instruct staff to revoke the Conditional Use Permit for Car Parts Direct to operate a salvage yard at 440 Winnebago Avenue and provide 90 days from the day of revocation for Car Parts Direct and property owners to apply for new conditional use permits.
2. Approve the Conditional Use Permit's extension another year for Car Parts Direct to operate a salvage yard at 440 Winnebago Avenue.

BACKGROUND

On February 2, 2021, the Planning Commission gave the applicant 90 days to apply for new or amended conditional use permits for any property where their business is active. The applicant has applied for conditional use permits for 440 Winnebago Avenue and 1313 North Hampton Street to continue operations related to salvage, storage, auto repair, and auto sales.

In February, staff recommended that the existing conditional use permit for 440 Winnebago Avenue be revoked and that the applicant be given 90 days to apply for new permits because Car Parts Direct violated four of the original permit's 12 conditions, injuring the public welfare.

Staff evaluate the new requests for both properties in this single report for the purpose of clarity. Where there are differences in conditions or recommendations between the properties, those are specified.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

The Fairmont 2040 Comprehensive Plan guides the use of this neighborhood as Traditional Family Residential. The long-range vision for this section of the Winnebago Avenue corridor is to develop single-family homes and small format multifamily residential homes close to the ballpark.

The properties are currently zoned I-1 Light Industrial. The zoning district allows salvage yards as a conditional use if certain standards are met, including that the proposal be in conformance with the City's comprehensive plan.

The applicant's description of the use of the 1313 North Hampton Street is "storage." The property is currently used to store more than 10 vehicles of varying degrees of operability. *City Code Section 26-160* designates that conditional uses include "auto, truck, farm implement and salvage yards of more than 10 units." Staff interpret this Code to include the current and proposed use of the property as needing a conditional use permit.

The applicant's description of the use of the 440 Winnebago Ave is "auto repair/salvage yard/auto sales." Auto repair is a permitted use of the zoning district and does not require a conditional use permit. As discussed above, salvage yards require a conditional use permit here. Per *City Code Section*

26-160, auto sales require a conditional use permit here because they are normally permitted in a B-3 General Business district.

Taken together, staff evaluate a proposed conditional use permit for 440 Winnebago Ave for a salvage yard of more than 10 units and auto sales, understanding that the property is also used for auto repair. Staff evaluate a proposed conditional use permit for 1313 North Hampton Street for a salvage yard of more than 10 units.

REVIEW OF CONDITIONAL USE STANDARDS

City Code Section 26-80 sets standards for reviewing proposed conditional use permits:

1. Must be in conformance with the comprehensive plan.

The 2040 Comprehensive Plan guides the long-term use of the neighborhood, including both parcels, as Traditional Family Residential. This designation includes single-family homes with the potential for small format multifamily residential and small format commercial uses.

Staff assess that the proposed uses are incompatible with the Comprehensive Plan's long-term vision for the neighborhood. Salvage yards are generally light industrial in nature and include frequent hauling of vehicles, parts salvaging, local pollution emission, and some loud noise. In staff's opinion, they are better placed in areas of the community that are away from residences and close to other light or heavy industrial uses. Auto sales here are likely less impactful but are still inconsistent with the long-term vision of the neighborhood.

2. Must not be detrimental or injurious to the general vicinity and uses already permitted in the area.

Surrounding uses are generally residential: single family homes are adjacent to both sites. During last year's annual review of the existing conditional use permit for 440 Winnebago Ave, staff found violations of conditions set forth by the Planning Commission which injured the surrounding public welfare. By staff's assessment, these violations indicated that the use expanded over time, added new components, and outgrew a single lot to eventually becoming much more impactful to the neighborhood than what was originally envisioned.

Additionally, the lack of adequate off-street parking to accommodate the combination of uses for both employees and customers frequently results in the public parking lot across the street being used by employees and customers which was intended for the public to visit the ball fields.

3. Must not impede the normal and orderly development of surrounding vacant property.

Staff evaluate that development of single-family homes and small format multifamily homes will be limited by the proposals because their proximity to salvage yards or auto sales businesses may be undesirable.

4. Will be served by adequate utilities, public roads, and municipal facilities. Such requirements for public facilities shall not be detrimental to the economic welfare of the city.

Staff find that both sites would be adequately served by public infrastructure.

5. Must not cause offensive odors, fumes, dust, noise, and vibration that would be injurious or a nuisance to adjacent uses and the surrounding area.

The applicant proposes to place a 8-foot tall fence around the area used for storage of vehicles at 1313 N Hampton St. However, some offensive odors, fumes, dust, noise, or vibration may emit from the normal operation of salvage vehicle storage.

6. Will conform to specific standards of this chapter applicable to the particular use.

Auto, truck, farm implement, and salvage yards of more than 10 units

6(a). Provide eight-foot screening.

The applicant proposes to place a 8-foot fence around the outside portion of salvage storage at the 1313 N Hampton St site.

6(b). Provisions made to control and reduce the number of units stored outside the screening.

The applicant proposes to store all salvage vehicles within fencing and only allow customer parking in front of the 440 Winnebago Ave site.

6(c). Provide for adequate access to all parts of yard for firefighting equipment.

The applicant proposes to comply with this requirement.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff believe that the proposal for salvage and auto storage yards at 440 Winnebago Avenue and 1313 North Hampton Street and an auto sales business at 440 Winnebago Avenue are incompatible with the vision of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan. The Plan guides the long-term character of the neighborhood as Traditional Single Family residential. The proposed use is inconsistent with that guidance and will likely detract from future single-family residential and small format multifamily development.

In general, because of the accumulative nature of the current and proposed use, staff believe that the use's impact will likely grow to affect more of the residential neighborhood. This is evidenced by the use growing beyond the original permit's conditions and the applicant's intention to acquire additional parcels.

Staff believe that salvage yards, along with auto storage and service are important services that the community relies on. However, it is clear that other areas of town could better accommodate the proposals.

For these reasons, staff do not support granting conditional use permits for a salvage yard and auto sales business at 440 Winnebago Avenue and an auto/salvage storage yard at 1313 North Hampton Street.

If conditional use permits were to be granted, staff offer the following conditions for consideration:

1. That the business maintain an active industrial stormwater permit from Minnesota Pollution Control Agency and follow the guidance in Minnesota Pollution Control Agency document p-p2s8-03 "Sector M: Automotive salvage yards."
2. That suitable impervious surface be placed beneath the storage of any vehicle or part, and that storm water runoff is controlled and/or treated to prevent oil, gas, or other contaminants from entering the storm water system.
3. That any required land disturbance permitting be obtained for site grading activities greater than 5,000 square feet.
4. That the architectural appearance and functional plan of the building and site shall not be so dissimilar to the existing buildings or area so as to cause impairment in property values or constitute a blighting influence within a reasonable distance of the lot. All fencing must be maintained so as the passing public may not see into its confines.
5. That the lighting shall be accomplished in such a way as to have no direct source of light visible from adjacent land in residential use or from a public right-of-way.
6. That vehicular access points shall create a minimum of conflict with through traffic movement and shall comply with the requirements of this chapter.
7. That open storage and refuse from the use shall be adequately contained and controlled on-site. Parts and equipment must be stored indoors or within required screening.
8. Business hours are not before 6:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m.
9. All vehicles associated with any use of the property be stored indoors or within required screening except vehicles driven to the site that same day by employees or customers.
10. (A) *440 Winnebago Ave*: No more than 25 vehicles associated with any use are stored on the property at any given time.

(B) *1313 N Hampton St*: No more than 50 vehicles associated with any use are stored on the property at any given time.

11. That the business does not produce noise, light, or odor that is offensive to neighboring properties.

Below are conditions that the Planning Commission may consider if approving conditional use permits for Car Parts Direct at 440 Winnebago Avenue and 1313 N Hampton Street.

Staff consulted with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, who confirmed that the business needs industrial stormwater permitting. Because of the difficulty in identifying vehicles that are associated with various uses, staff continue to recommend that the number of vehicles allowed on each property be capped at a single overall number to deter the use from expanding within the residential neighborhood.

A number of standards are taken from the original conditional use permit.

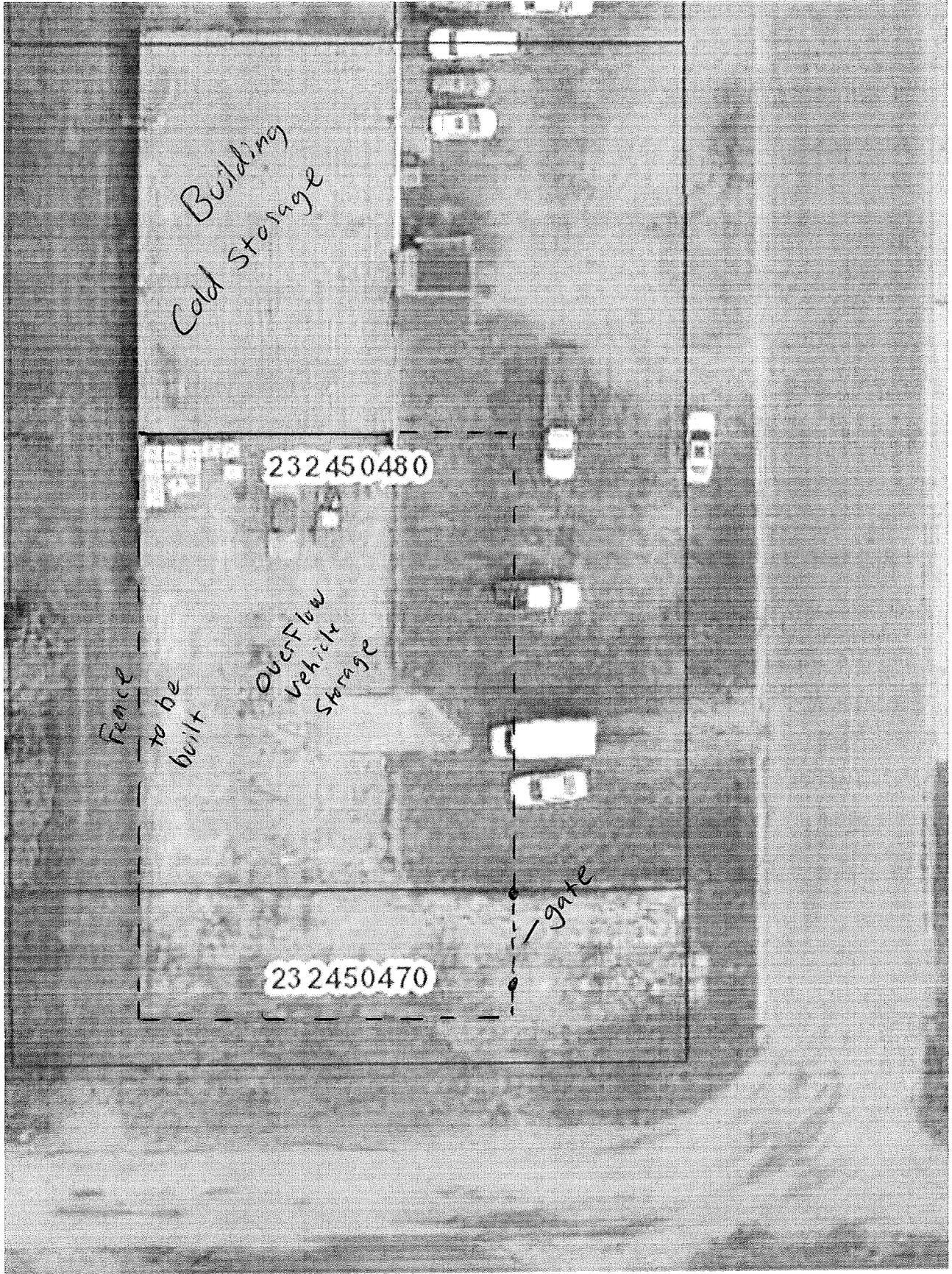

Policy/Action Requested: To approve Resolution 2021-37 awarding the CR 39 Sanitary Sewer and Watermain Extension Project, Project 2021-I, to Holtmeier Construction.

Vote Required: Simple Majority Roll Call

Recommendation: Staff is recommending approval.

Overview: A bid opening for this project was held on Wednesday, June 23rd at 2pm. Five bids were opened with the low bid of \$714,564.37 received from Holtmeier Construction. The engineer’s estimate for this project was \$940,605. A recommendation letter from Bolton & Menk is attached. Staff is recommending awarding the bid to Holtmeier Construction.

The City received grant funding from MN DEED to extend utilities along CR 39 from the County Fairgrounds north towards the interstate. FEDA has an option to purchase a 40-acre parcel in the southwest quadrant of the intersection of CR 39 and I-90. This utility extension would provide water and sewer service for potential development of this site. The improvements include the addition of a lift station to serve the surrounding areas should future development occur.

Budget Impact: This project was budgeted for in 2021 public utilities budget. The City is receiving a 50% grant from the MN DEED to offset the cost of this project.
