Monthly update: Nick Lardy provided an update on current park staff activities and park openings. All parks are open. Pools are being filled and prepared. New dock at Amber Lake boat landing. Explained soccer field dead grass rehab and leveling plans.

CER update: Stephanie Busiahn CER Director was unable to attend. She provided an update report that was handed to the board for review.

Old Business: City Council Member Randy Lubenow asked about the status of food trucks being allowed in parks. It was discussed that food trucks are currently allowed in parks with special event permits and allowed on private property without a permit. Nick Lardy will discuss with Troy Nemmers and provide updates, if any, at next park board meeting.

New Business: City Council member Britney Kawecki presented a citizen's idea for winter wind protection at the dog park. They would like to do a fundraiser at the Knights of Columbus to raise money to install 3 walls on the existing pergolas in both the small and large dog areas. The board is in favor of the idea. Nick Lardy will check with the building official to determine if the current structure would be sufficient to accommodate. Will update at next council meeting.

Other discussion: Greg Gellert was contacted by Dave and Beth Kloeckner requesting a basketball hoop to be placed at the Fairmont Soccer Complex in the northeast corner of the parking lot. Nick Lardy will check into it.
