Other discussion: Vicki Schulte asked for info on curfew and fines. Nick Lardy will talk with FPD and provide information at next meeting.

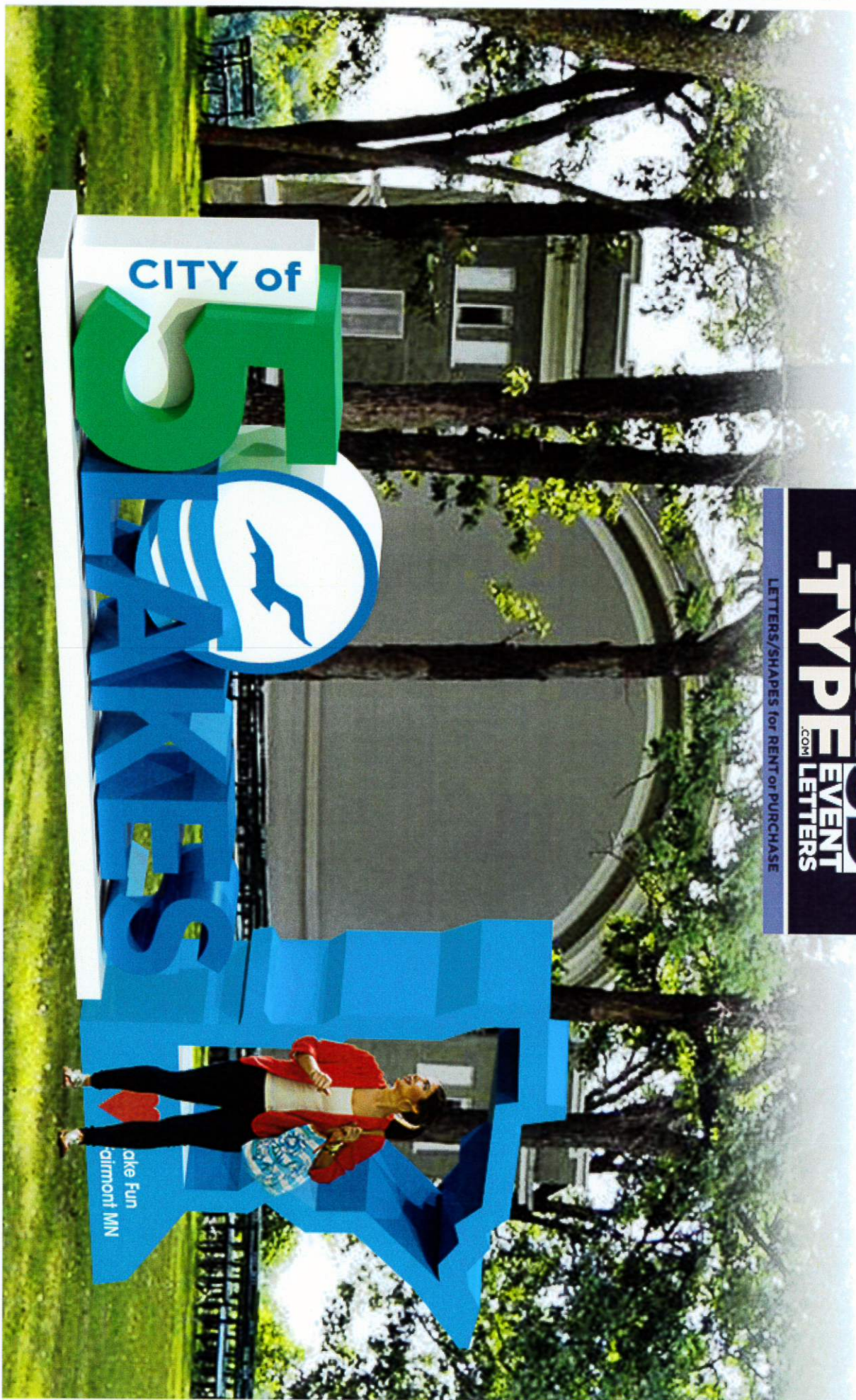
A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 5:56 p.m.
