The aeronautical imagery flight mission and ground survey work have been completed. KLJ is compiling the FAA Grant Application for submittal to the FAA and MnDOT. The project will primarily be in a holding pattern until the grant is in place per previous discussions between the city/airport and KLJ.

Airfield Pavement Maintenance

KLJ #2305-01532

State Grant #A4601-59 (Pending)

The project will consist of crack sealing and large crack repairs on all airfield pavements. Quotes were received in December 2023. KLJ is compiling the Letter of Recommendation and State Grant Application for Submittal to the City and MnDOT in early January 2024. Construction will be planned for 2024 construction season.

OTHER ITEMS

 Rehabilitate Terminal Building (Exterior): The City/Airport accepted a state fiscal year 2022 grant for the Rehabilitate Terminal Building (Exterior) project. The work on the project is being coordinated by the City/Airport and is expected to be completed in spring 2024.



 Obstruction Removals: Trees northwest of Runway 13 End were penetrating the MnDOT 34:1 approach surface according to MnDOT 5010 inspection reports. KLJ and City/Airport determine steps required for environmental clearance for tree removal/trimming. The City/Airport coordinated the tree trimming areas required with MnDOT and completed the obstruction removal work in December 2023.
