Note from Interim City Administrator Jeff O'Neill:

At this workshop, staff will be presenting a list of fees currently charged by the City for various services. This will be the first time that the City Council has seen fees listed on one document. Thank you, Patty, for compiling this information from various sources.

It is our goal for the workshop to focus on the new fees or fees proposed for increase. If Council desires to discuss certain fees in more detail, we can set those fees apart for future discussion or go back to them later in the meeting as time allows. The fees relating to electricity, sewer, water, etc. require input from the Public Utilities Commission. Consequently, Council will be asked to adopt these fees in the future after PUC reviews and makes their recommendation.

The presentation will be organized with Staff members reviewing fees pertinent to their department.

From a best practice standpoint and according to State Law, fees must be fair, reasonable, and proportionate and have a nexus to the actual cost of the service for which the fee is imposed. Also, a municipality may adopt a fee schedule by ordinance or resolution, either annually or more frequently, following publication of notice of proposed action on a fee schedule at least ten days prior to a public hearing held to consider action on or approval of the fee schedule. Accordingly, staff will provide notice for a public hearing at the next city council meeting at which time the schedule should be considered for adoption.
